

Message# 340_5-25-2025 – Possessed by Evil Spirits

Preached first on 5/25/2025

Good morning everyone. Thank you for tuning into the message this morning.

Please remember those who are on the Prayer Request page on the website.

Before we get fully into the “Possessed by Evil Spirits” message, I want to say a couple more things about last week's message. The questions are applicable to the series, say I guess I should just say we're getting right into the message. Here's a question for you.

This is purely hypothetical. I am not suggesting anyone give up this area of life. It's basic freedom. We have - for lack of a better word - the “right” to move ourselves from one place to another - anywhere we want to on God's Creation - without asking any man for permission to do so. As long as - we do not violate the Laws of God in doing so. And, this includes trespasses. You don't have a “right” to enter into someone's house without their permission. Even if you are not entering to steal or kill, etc., you do not have the “right” to trespass. So, yes, there are limits to a man's freedom to move himself wherever he wants to go. But as long as the man is not violating the Laws of God - including trespassing - his ability to move himself around from one place to another must not be infringed. And when someone does infringe on a man's ability to move himself around - that is kidnapping. The Law of God calls it man-stealing.

And the punishment is actually the death penalty. It's very serious business. And, once again, with just about everything else in life, most people's concept of kidnapping is what has been defined in a Hollywood movie. Someone gets taken from their family and a note is left behind saying “pay ransom and don't tell the cops or we'll kill granny.” Then the kidnapped person's family decides to call the cops anyway and Charles Bronson figures out a way to get granny back without losing the ransom money and most of the time, the kidnappers die a bloody death in the process.

This is fantasy. It's another diversion to make people believe that something is one thing - while it is really something else. Kind of like that pesky devil creature. Never would we ever want anyone to know that in the Bible - the representatives of man's little g “governments” the kingdoms of the world - are the Bible definition of demons, devils, satans, etc. So kidnapping must also be changed in the minds of the people - so that the demons that run men's little g “governments” can kidnap people all day everyday - and do so without any repercussions. Listen to this. This is from - and this

doesn't make bit of difference to me - the Cornell Law Institute website. This is one of the most popular places that lawyers go to for definitions, cases, etc. Quote:

Kidnapping is a crime at common law consisting of an unlawful restraint of a person's liberty by force or show of force.

Think about it. Cop comes up to you and he's got a gun on his side and says, "You're not going anywhere." Well, there you have it.

Listen to this. This is interesting, too. I typed in, "charges of kidnapping for holding someone against their will." This came back:

Yes, a person could face kidnapping charges for holding someone against their will. Kidnapping laws generally define this as unlawfully seizing, confining, or abducting someone and holding them against their will. Depending on the specific laws of the state or jurisdiction, the charges can range from simple kidnapping to aggravated kidnapping, with corresponding penalties.

Elements of Kidnapping

Unlawful restraint: The person is taken or kept against their will, without their consent.

Intent: The person taking the victim intends to detain them or move them against their will.

Movement or confinement: The victim is either moved to another location or confined in a specific place.

Penalties for Kidnapping

Kidnapping can be a felony offense, and the severity of the charges and penalties can vary depending on the jurisdiction. Penalties can include imprisonment, fines, and other sanctions.

Federal kidnapping charges, under 18 U.S.C. § 1201, carry significant penalties, potentially including life imprisonment or even the death penalty in some cases.

Examples

If someone locks someone in a room against their will.

If someone takes a person at gunpoint to a different location.

If someone lures a person into a vehicle and drives them away against their will.

Of course they're going to leave out the cop holding someone against their will, because they have an air freshener hanging from their rear view mirror.

Defenses to Kidnapping

Consent: If the person being taken or confined consented to the actions, it may not be kidnapping.

And of course, the most important defense to kidnapping:

Legal authority: If the person taking or confining the other person has legal authority to do so (e.g., law enforcement), it may not be kidnapping.

It's important to note that the specific laws and definitions of kidnapping can vary by jurisdiction, so it's crucial to consult with legal professionals for accurate information and advice.

So, here again, you've got man's "government" the kingdoms of the world - making exceptions to the Law of God. They say the Laws of God do not apply to them. They redefine, or do away with, the Laws of God.

So...back to the my hypothetical question. If you never got behind the wheel of a car again - would you ever have a concern for being charged for violating any of the millions of "laws, statutes, ordinances, rules, regulations, etc.," that mere men have created to keep people from exercising their God mandated command to move themselves around? Ok. I get it. Too much commentary of my own added obvious bias. So let me state it again.

If you never got behind the wheel of a car again - would you ever be stopped for rolling through a stop sign? Or going 36 in a 35? Or hanging an air-freshener from your rear view mirror? Can't seem to get away from the commentary in asking a simple question. Try again.

If you never got behind the wheel of a car again - would you ever get stopped by the cops?

Of course not. That's pretty simple. Not talking about being a passenger - which of course could get you arrested. I'm saying if you never got behind the wheel of a car again - could you be arrested for "operating a motor vehicle without a license?" Of course not. Not even in their insane world.

Now, I have seen people get arrested for walking down the street and failing to or refusing to give a cop an id - but that's not what I'm asking.

My point is simply this - you reduce your chances of being hassled by demons if you do not enter their realm. If you are not involved with the demons - your chance of being hassled by them pretty much drops to zero.

The same principle applies to their "tax system." If you do not enter the realm of their demonic system - their antichrist, antigod, antibible tax system, your chance of being hassled by those demons pretty much drops to zero.

If you recall, from the email I was reading last week, the writer acknowledged the fact that he had heard about social security numbers, w2s w4s and whatever other ws they have in that demonic world. Using those numbers - and I've shown this many times - at least in my opinion - from my perspective of studying the Bible through the lens that God's people are only supposed to be Citizens of His Country, His Nation - we aren't supposed to be or act like we are citizens of the world - we should not have their numbers, we should not have their identification marks - none of that. We are Citizens of a different Country and we don't identify with the kingdoms of the world.

Using their numbers, using their ids, taking their ws and all of that - means we are entering into the realm of demons and we are asking for trouble. You aren't going to be a citizen of the world - identified with the world - then not do what they say. If you do that - you are going to get spanked. When you use their numbers, when you identify with them - you are expected to obey the millions and millions of "laws, statutes, ordinances, rules, regulations, etc.," that they have come up with and if you don't you are going to be treated like a rebellious citizen and they are going to come against you with all the forces of demonic evil they have.

So. It's pretty simple. Stop doing the things that cause you to enter into the realm of demons. If you say you are a Christian, a follower of Jesus Christ, then follow Him and stop following the world. Stop using their numbers. Stop using their ids. Stop doing the things that cause you to enter into the realm of the demonic spirits - the attitudes of

the men who openly oppose the God of the Bible - the One that you say you are following - by insisting on forcing people to live by their definitions of good and evil, right and wrong - otherwise known as what they falsely call "laws, statutes, ordinances, etc." The God of the Bible is the Only One allowed to create Laws, Statutes and Ordinances.

When we see from the Word of God - that He and He Alone is the One allowed to make Law - and we believe it. This is faith. This is belief. And when we trust that belief system - our lives will change and we will be led by the Spirit of God into living a life that conforms to this simple belief system. He didn't tell us to live this way then make it impossible not to. But it takes conviction. It takes commitment. It takes perseverance. It is an unwavering system of belief - faith - that is not compromised. Turn to II Timothy chapter 2. Read beginning with verse 1. Simple truth. Simple faith. This is the faith, this is the system of belief once delivered to the saints. This is a foundational tenet of belief for the Christian.

- [1] Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.
- [2] And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.
- [3] Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.
- [4] No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please Him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life;

Christians are not to be entangled with the world. I learned this when I was 19 years old. When I understood this for the first time - it literally rocked my world. It forever changed my perspective and caused me to have unwavering commitment to this faith - to this system of belief - and I can tell you - that from the day I understood this - I never had another entanglement with the affairs of this life. I understood the numbers were entanglements. I understood agreements with the world were entanglements and as a Christian - I could not be entangled with the world. All of this perfectly lines up with the command to

Come out from among them and be separate.

The God of the Bible, the God of Israel, the God, the Ruler, the Judge, the Magistrate, the Lawgiver of the World is supposed to be our God - our Ruler. Come out from the

mindsent, come up from the ideology of the world that says it's perfectly fine for men to make their own "governments", to make their own "laws" their own definitions of good and evil, right and wrong. Leave that way of thinking, that way of living and follow Christ. Turn back to Ephesians chapter 6. Read beginning in verse 10.

[10] Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might.

[11] Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

Where is there an example of this taking place in another place? Standing against the wiles of the devil? Is Ephesians 6:11 the first time we see this in our Bibles. No. It's not.

As will be in all these messages, keep your finger here, turn back to Matthew chapter 4 - and we'll read what is the main focus of this series of messages on what it means to be Possessed by Evil Spirits.

[1] Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.

Is this devil - here in Matthew chapter 4 - is this devil the same one or the same thing that Paul is talking about in Ephesians 6? Not that this is how we would say Yes - that it is one and the same. But it does provide some insight. The exact same Greek word that's used in Matthew 4 for devil - is the exact same one that is used in Ephesians 6.

But even more so than that - we're going to see that in context - they are both used in the exact same way. It's about the kingdoms of the world. The devil in Matthew 4 - and the devil in Ephesians 6 are both representatives of the kingdoms of the world - the little g "governments" of men. This should not be hard. Verse 2.

[2] And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, He was afterward an hungred.

[3] And when the tempter came to Him, he said, If Thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.

[4] But He answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

This is - or this should be - so abundantly clear for the follower of Christ. Christ is saying that man - and He's not limiting that to followers of Christ only - He is saying that all

men are to live by every Word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. And we know from our previous study that this is a direct reference to the Law of God. Men are to live by God's Laws and not their own.

What do we do? What's next now that we know that all Bible prophecy has been fulfilled? Well, that answer was actually provided - even way before Christ confirmed it.

Man is to live by every Word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

This is how a man is supposed to live. Men say, "No, you live the way we say to live." Christ said, "No, man is to live by every Word that comes from God." It's one or the other. Because the two oppose each other and have opposed each other ever since Adam was first tempted by the same spirit that was in the garden. So, this devil first tempts Christ with just his words. That didn't work. Then we see this.

[5] Then the devil taketh Him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple,

Now this devil is going to tempt Christ with the holy city of Jerusalem and with things pertaining to the temple. He's going to tempt Christ with religion.

[6] And saith unto Him, If Thou be the Son of God, cast Thyself down: for it is written, He shall give His angels charge concerning Thee: and in their hands they shall bear Thee up, lest at any time Thou dash Thy foot against a stone.

[7] Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.

That didn't work. And why? Because Christ had an uncompromising conviction, an unwavering commitment to live exclusively by the Words of His Father - and He was providing the example for all those who came after Him - that this is the way to respond to the temptations of devils.

[8] Again, the devil taketh Him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth Him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

[9] And saith unto Him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship Me.

Fall down and worship. This is not the idea this is not the mental picture that should come to our minds of when you see modern days jews on their knees wailing and

crying at the “Wailing wall.” This is not the modern concept of apostate “church” people waving their arms in the air, dancing around like a bunch of idiots.

This fall down means to come down from your position of Authority. It means to renounce that your Father is the Only Lawgiver. It means to renounce that God is the Creator and the sole Ruler of the World and all that's in it. And when those things are done - then it means to submit to the power of the kingdoms of the world who are in place to war against the Government of God. That's what they have always done. That's what they still do today. They are in place to force people to obey their “laws, statutes, ordinances, CONstitutions” and in doing so - they keep people from submitting their lives exclusively to the Law of God and from being Citizens of that Government that all the Bible saints declared they were hoping for and looking to.

Worship me, worship this devil. It's not worship as what the world thinks worship is. It's simply obeying. Worship is the same as serve. Serve is the same as obey. This is about renouncing the Government of God and submitting to the “governments” of men.

[10] Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve.

The God of the Bible is not interested in our waving arms in the air. He's not interested in our songs of praise - when our lives are not being lived in obedience to Him - exclusive obedience to Him. The worship of God means serving Him. Which means obeying His Laws.

[11] Then the devil leaveth Him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto Him.

Now back to Ephesians chapter 6 again. Read verse 11 again. No, just start over again at verse 10.

[10] Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might.

[11] Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

Be unwavering. Be uncompromised. Be convicted and committed - just like Christ was in Matthew chapter 4 who showed by example - what it meant to be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. The devil came against Christ with multiple temptations

and Christ never compromised. And why? Because Christ was committed to living by every Word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. When we do this - there's no room for anything or anyone else.

[12] For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Come on now, friends. This also is not hard. Should not be hard. This is talking about man's "governments." This is exactly what the devil showed Christ in Matthew chapter 4.

[8] Again, the devil taketh Him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth Him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

[9] And saith unto Him, All these things will I give thee, if Thou wilt fall down and worship Me.

I've said this before, go to pretty much any county in the u.s. - not including the megawealthy places like New York city, Los Angeles, etc., just this. Go to any normal sized county in the u.s. and what building is typically the most extravagant in town? The "government" building. Then, consider all the pomp and grandeur of the states and the federals. Look at Washington DC. Look at all the extravagant buildings. All the pomp and grandeur. This is

the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

This is all talking about the little g "governments" of the world. Off the subject a little. A while back I was ridiculed because of the way I say "little g governments of the world." Why do I do this - or at least try to do this every time I say the phrase? It's because the Only God Ordained Government in the world today is the Government of God and I use that with a capital G - for emphasis. Standing out as the only Government allowed to exist and all others are impostors. They are fake. They are illegitimate. It's like the times where I have pointed out before that in the old English versions - whenever the word King referred to Christ - it was always with a capital K and when the word king referred to the kings of the world - it was with a small k. Same thing applies. Talk about the Government of God - capital G. Talk about men - little g. It's about making sure we know which one is real and which one isn't. Which one is legitimate, which one is illegitimate.

I will not....well first of all, of the times I have been challenged in my saying that Matthew 4 and Ephesians 6 are talking about man's little g "governments" no one has ever given me an even shred of evidence or argument that these passages are not talking about man's "government." This is talking about the devil offering Jesus a beer or a movie ticket, or going to a dance hall. It's talking about renouncing the Government of God and following the "government" of the devil.

And, of course, the only people that ever argue against these passages referring to men's little g "governments" are those who think it's perfectly fine to have them. Well, it's not perfectly fine to have them. They stand in opposition to the God of Heaven. They stand in opposition to Christ the King and they are in place to force every man woman boy and girl to serve them - to live by - to obey their definitions of good and evil, right and wrong.

[13] Wherefore [because of all of this] take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

We are called to stand. We are called to stand for the truth that God and God alone is supposed to be the Ruler of the World. And, you do realize that every "churchman" around the world would stand and say Amen. But when pressed at to why people don't live that way today - the answer will be "because the time isn't right. Some day, He will come again. And when He comes again, then will He be the Ruler of the world and every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that He is Lord - the One Who is Supreme in Authority."

We are called to stand. Just like the first century saints were called to stand. We may not have all the answers - but we are called to stand. And again,

[14] Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

[15] And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

[16] Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

[17] And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God:

[18] Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

[19] And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my

mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the Gospel,

Who needs boldness to preach the Gospel? Ha. Today, in our time, who needs boldness to stand for, to preach the Gospel? Well, when you understand that the real Gospel is indeed a mystery - when we try make known that mystery - yeah - we need boldness. When we understand that the Gospel is the Gospel of the Kingdom. It's not fairytale changed gospel of the "church." It's the Gospel of the Government of God. It's that men and women, boys and girls are to come out from the kingdoms of the world - just like the example of Christ from Matthew 4 - Christ did not enter into the realm of devils. Christ refused the kingdoms of the world. That is the Gospel of the Kingdom. It's coming into the Government of God. It's leaving the mindset behind of believing and living according to the words of men - and committing ourselves to a life of living by every Word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. Yes. When we begin to reveal the mystery of the Gospel - it requires boldness. The same type of boldness that Paul was asking for.

[20] For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

Last time I checked and admittedly it's been a long long time age - now - there are certainly spiritual jails in the "churches." They are certainly holding men's minds captive in spiritual jails, spiritual prisons. But I don't think they have dungeons and jail cells. But men's little g "governments" certainly do. The language here that Paul is using is not of a spiritual nature such that it has no physical meaning. The bonds that Paul was talking about were physical jails. They were physical imprisonments. And he was there for revealing the mystery of the Gospel.

[21] But that ye also may know my affairs, and how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things:

[22] Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that ye might know our affairs, and that he might comfort your hearts.

[23] Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

[24] Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.

The second thing I wanted to say to you - and it was also about not being entangled - not entering the realm of the devils, the demons, the satans - men's little g "governments." People want to know how do I come into the Government of God and

reduce my potential for persecution. And I get that. No one wants to be persecuted. But I can't tell you that if you Come into the Government of God it will not be without persecution.

Years ago now, one of our brothers make a very public announcement that he was leaving the world - leaving the realm of satans - leaving the world's marks - no numbers - no ids - leaving the world. He was convicted that it was sin. It was not the life of the Christian, the true follower of Christ - and he was going to enter into the Government of God. He then did exactly what he had publicly declared.

A couple years ago I asked him if he ever hears from the IRS. And what do you think his answer was? And friends, this was not a young man, a teenager who was barely starting out in life. This was a man who had been a citizen of the U.S. for his whole life - a long time. And he renounced it. He entered the Government of God. And, when he stopped using their devices, their entanglements, he no longer heard from them. They spank their own children - when their children get out of what they think is the "line." They don't typically spank other children. When we leave their realm - they will typically leave us alone.

Now. I'm not going to tell you that there will never be trouble. I had been out of their realm for more than 35 years - I barely tipped my toe in when I was a kid - when they decided to declare war on me. But, they did not prevail against me. They tried. They tried for almost five years. They looked everywhere they could to try to find inconsistency in what my public conviction was - and what was reality. But they couldn't find anything - because there wasn't anything. I had stood on the fact that I had not entered their realm. No numbers. No IDs. Nothing to tie me to their world, to their "government." And I believe today that if they would have found somewhere, that I was in fact still using their numbers, their IDs, I believe that I would not be here speaking to you today.

I asked the cop one day - when you raped our home - did you find anything in that house that tied me to your "government?" You would not believe his answer. It was so weird. I just shook my head pretty much in disbelief. When I asked him if he found anything that tied me to his "government" or as some say, "to their jurisdiction" - his answer was - "your clothes were in your closet." Yeah. That's weird. What an odd thing to say. But that was the best he had - and it made no sense at all.

So back to the older guy who later in life left their world. It's easy to talk about the guy

who entered the Government of God at a very young age. But what about the old guy who had been in it up to his neck for many years? They could easily find instances where he used their numbers, their ids - and couldn't they use that against him? The answer is no. Under these circumstances. And I saw this in their system when they were coming against me. I saw them put paperwork on their court record. Then, I watched them withdraw that paperwork, basically saying, "We were in error" - and then - when I tried to bring up their error - that "judge" yelled at me and said - "They admitted their mistake and you can't talk about it anymore". Well, ok. Thank you for that information.

So, the follower of Christ says - on such and such date, I realized that I had been living my life completely in error. I confess my error and I renounce my past - and I am starting over from this date in my life. And guess what? They can't go back and use your past against you - listen now - as far as that relates to their "statutes." As far as God's Laws - if a man commits murder - of course - he can confess, he can ask forgiveness and even receive forgiveness - but there will still be a price to pay. I'm telling you that there is a way out of man's definitions of good and evil, right and wrong - there's a way out of man's world their "statutes." You admit you were wrong. You admit you lived a life of sin. And you renounce it. You make your claim to entering into God's Government then live your life according to your public confession.

When we enter into the Government of Christ - we leave the world behind and all the things that are entanglements. Contracts, licenses, ids - all of those things are entanglements with devils, with demons, with satans. And I'll close this message with this. Turn to II Corinthians chapter 6. We've seen this many times - and rightly so. It is one of the most fundamental, foundational tenets of a Christian's faith. And, I believe when we implement this into our lives - it is a shield. It's just like what Paul talked about in Ephesians 6 about taking the shield of faith. It's protection. It's protection against the wiles of devils. Verse 14.

[14] Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

[15] And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

Concord. Agreement. Contract. Christ has no agreement with Belial. Is this the first time we read about Belial in our Bibles? Nope. Keep your finger here and turn back to Deuteronomy 13. This is the first time the word Belial is found in our Bibles. Read

beginning with verse 1.

[1] If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and giveth thee a sign or a wonder,

[2] And the sign or the wonder come to pass, whereof he spake unto thee, saying, Let us go after other gods [rulers, judges, magistrates], which thou hast not known, and let us serve them;

And again. What is the meaning of the word gods? It means rulers, judges, magistrates.

[3] Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for the LORD your God proveth you, to know whether ye love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

[4] Ye shall walk after the LORD your God, and fear Him, and keep His Commandments, and obey His voice, and ye shall serve Him, and cleave unto Him.

[5] And that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams, shall be put to death; because he hath spoken to turn you away from the LORD your God [your Judge, your Ruler, your Magistrate, your Government, your Nation], which brought you out of the land of Egypt, and redeemed you out of the house of bondage, to thrust thee out of the way which the LORD thy God commanded thee to walk in. So shalt thou put the evil away from the midst of thee.

[6] If thy brother, the son of thy mother, or thy son, or thy daughter, or the wife of thy bosom, or thy friend, which is as thine own soul, entice thee secretly, saying, Let us go and serve other gods [rulers, judges, magistrates], which thou hast not known, thou, nor thy fathers;

[7] Namely, of the gods of the people which are round about you [rulers, judges, magistrates], nigh unto thee, or far off from thee, from the one end of the earth even unto the other end of the earth;

[8] Thou shalt not consent unto him, nor hearken unto him; neither shall thine eye pity him, neither shalt thou spare, neither shalt thou conceal him:

[9] But thou shalt surely kill him; thine hand shall be first upon him to put him to death, and afterwards the hand of all the people.

[10] And thou shalt stone him with stones, that he die; because he hath sought to thrust thee away from the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.

[11] And all Israel shall hear, and fear, and shall do no more any such wickedness as this is among you.

[12] If thou shalt hear say in one of thy cities, which the LORD thy God hath given thee to dwell there, saying,

[13] Certain men, the children of Belial, are gone out from among you, and have withdrawn the inhabitants of their city, saying, Let us go and serve other gods [rulers, judges, magistrates], which ye have not known;

There it is. It's about living according to other rulers, judges and magistrates besides the God of Heaven. Now, back to II Corinthians chapter 6.

[16] And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

[17] Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

[18] And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be My sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.
